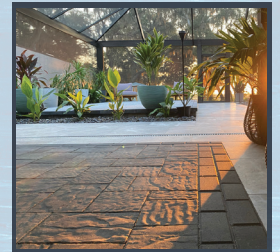

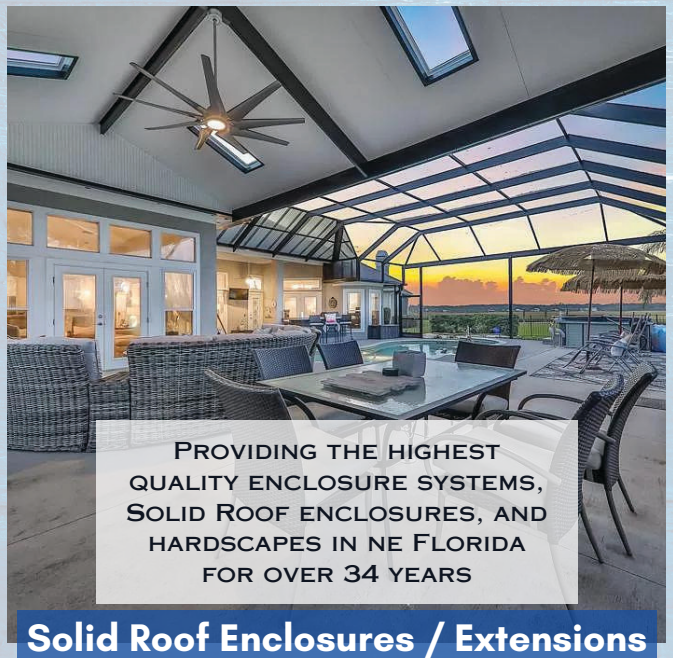

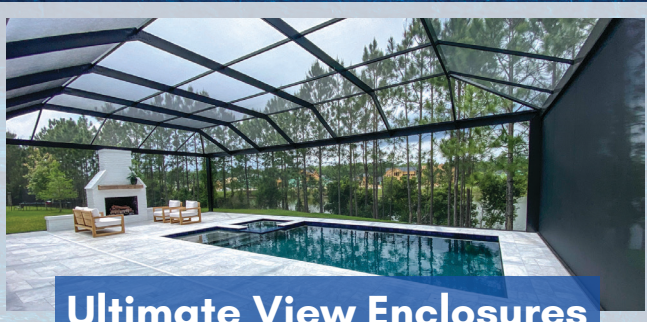

## **Anastasia State Park**

Anastasia State Park is comprised of 1,600 acres of rich ecosystems and abundant wildlife, including four miles of beach. Park attractions include a self-guided nature trail that winds through the maritime hammock and onto ancient sand dunes, and

a coquina quarry archeological site where coquina rock was mined to help construct the nearby Castillo de San Marcos national monument. Other park activities include bicycling, camping, geo-seeking and beachcombing.

Amelia Island State Park is one of the few locations on the East Coast that offers horseback riding on the beach and riding tours along the shoreline.

*Note: Beach parking at Amelia Island State Park is limited to 300 people at a time, with a maximum of 600 people per day. When the park reaches capacity at 300 people, it closes to new visitors. After about 150 people leave, the park reopens to allow more visitors.*

### ST. JOHNS COUNTY

Where to go if you're coming from:

**City of St. Augustine: (On the mainland)**

North on U.S. 1, turn west onto S.R. 16 or proceed south-west on S.R. 207 or south on U.S. 1, proceed to I-95 or points west.

**City of St. Augustine: (Davis Shores, Anastasia Island South to St. Augustine Alligator Farm)**

S.R. A1A, proceed west across Bridge of Lions, to U.S. 1 North or U.S. 1 South and/or to S.R. 16, or S.R. 207 to I-95 or points west.

**City of St. Augustine and Anastasia Island North of the St. Augustine Amphitheater**

Proceed north on S.R. A1A across the Bridge of Lions, then west.

**City of St. Augustine and Anastasia Island South of the St. Augustine Amphitheater**

Proceed south on S.R. A1A, turn west on S.R. 312, proceed across the 312 bridge to S.R. 207, proceed to I-95 or points west.

**City of St. Augustine Beach**

North to S.R. 312, proceed across the 312 bridge to S.R. 207, proceed to I-95 or points west.

**From the intersection of Ocean Trace Road and A1A to Crescent Beach**

South on S.R. A1A to Crescent Beach, turn west on



S.R. 206, proceed across Crescent Beach Bridge to U.S. 1, proceed to I-95 or points west.

**Crescent Beach to Flagler County line**

North on S.R. A1A to Crescent Beach, turn west on S.R. 206, proceed across Crescent Beach Bridge to U.S. 1, proceed to I-95 or points west.

**Palm Valley / Nocatee area**

Proceed south-west to C.R. 210, proceed to I-95 or points west.

**Ponte Vedra Beach / Sawgrass**

North on S.R. A1A, turn west onto Butler Boulevard, proceed to I-95 or points west.

**On coast halfway between Mickler's Landing and South Ponte Vedra Beach**

North of Guana Dam, go north to S.R. A1A, proceed west across the Palm Valley Bridge on C.R. 210. South of Guana Dam, go south on S.R. A1A, proceed west across Vilano Bridge. Continue west on S.R. 16 to I-95 or points west.

### ST. JOHNS RIVER

**S.R. 13 north of C.R. 210**

Proceed East along C.R. 210 or Greenbriar Road to I-95; or north along S.R. 13 into Duval County; or east on Racetrack Road to areas outside the evacuation zone.

**S.R. 13 north of C.R. 214**

Proceed east along C.R. 208 or S.R. 16 to I-95; or west along S.R. 16 across the Shands Bridge; or east on C.R. 214 to areas outside the evacuation zone.

**C.R. 13 south of C.R. 214**

Proceed east along S.R. 207 or S.R. 206 to I-95; or west along S.R. 207 into Putnam County; or east on C.R. 214 to areas outside the evacuation zone.

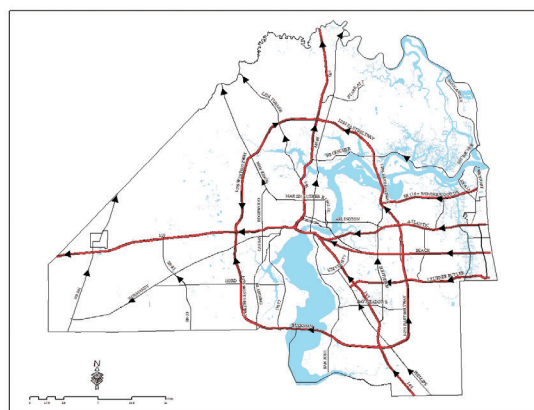
### DUVAL COUNTY

**Non-residents and Visitors:** Traffic will be routed from the southern point of entry into Duval County on I-95 North, onto I-295 North, and back onto I-95 North to exit the county.

**Residents:** Traffic will be routed westward from the Beaches community on either J. Turner Butler Boulevard, Beach Boulevard or Atlantic Boulevard. Traffic will then be routed westward through the downtown area to I-10 West until evacuees have entered

a public shelter, reached a safe area in the county, or departed the county. Other areas within the pre-designated evacuation zones, generally travel through the downtown area onto I-10 West until evacuees move into a shelter or depart Duval County.

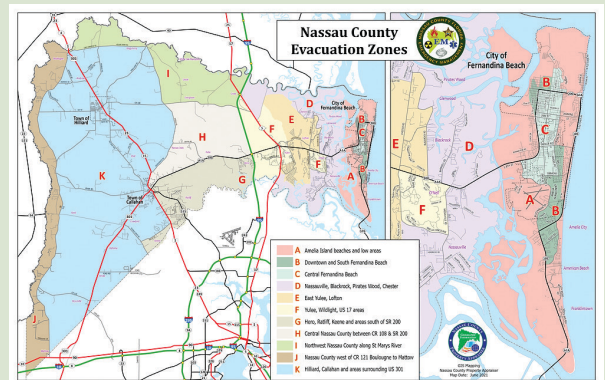

### NASSAU COUNTY

According to Nassau County Emergency Management, those evacuating the county during a hurricane should take either State Road 200/A1A; Heckscher Drive if they're going south or State Road 200 or U.S. Route 17 if they're coming from Yulee. For those in the west side of the county, emergency management officials advise taking U.S. 1 to evacuate.

### NASSAU COUNTY

#### GENERAL POPULATION

Nassau County Emergency Management has identified emergency shelters that will be open to anyone who needs a safe place to stay during a disaster. Emergency shelters may be crowded and uncomfortable with no privacy, and there is no guarantee of electricity. Service animals are accepted, pets or “comfort” animals are sheltered in separate designated areas of the shelters and must have proof of current

rabies vaccination as well as their own supplies. For a comprehensive list of supplies go to [OneNassau.com](http://OneNassau.com).

#### SPECIAL NEEDS

The Special Needs Shelter and Evacuation program is designed for those who require daily help with their medical and/or functional needs, and who might need government assistance to evacuate to an emergency shelter in the event of a disaster. This shelter will be open during disasters or emergency evacuation situations to accommodate evacuees requiring assistance with the daily activities of living.

Public Health nurses provide shelter supervision to help maintain the evacuees’ level of health, but personal caregivers must remain with and provide for the evacuees in the shelter.

The Special Needs Shelter and Evacuation Program requires annual enrollment in the registry. To get the Special Needs Registry enrollment form, go to [OneNassau.com](http://OneNassau.com), select “Special Needs During Evacuation” from the home page, then click the Enroll Online link to register. You can also call Nassau County Emergency Management staff at 904-548-0900.
