





There is also a camping fee of \$28 per night, plus a non-refundable reservation fee of \$6.70 and a \$7 nightly utility fee for RV, cabin, bungalow, boat and yurt units.

Anastasia State Park is comprised of 1,600 acres of rich ecosystems and abundant wildlife, including four miles of beach. Park attractions include a self-guided nature trail that winds through the maritime hammock and onto ancient sand dunes, and a coquina quarry archeological site where coquina rock was mined to help construct the nearby Castillo de San Marcos national monument. Other park activities include bicycling, camping, geo-seeking and beachcombing.
